Birth/1st Clinic Visit	Hepatitis B #1	Given in Hospital or at 1st office visit
1 Month WCC		
2 Month WCC	Pediarix #1 Vaxnuevance #1 HiB #1 Rotavirus #1 (PO)	Must be <u>6 weeks old</u> Rotavirus: cannot be started after 14 weeks and 6 days
4 Month WCC	Pediarix #2 Vaxnuevance #2 HiB #2 Rotavirus #2 (PO)	Must be at least <u>6 weeks after 2 month vaccines</u> Rotavirus: cannot be started after 14 weeks and 6 days. Final Dose must be given by the day the child turns 8 months
6 Month WCC	Pediarix #3 Vaxnuevance #3 HiB #3 Rotavirus #3 (PO)	Must be at least <u>6 weeks after 4 month vaccines</u> Rotavirus: Final Dose must be given by the day the child turns 8 months
9 Month WCC		
12 Month WCC	MMR #1 (SQ) Varicella #1 (SQ) Hepatitis A #1	Must be at least <u>12 months old</u> If MMR and Varicella not given on same day, must be separated by 28 days
15 Month WCC	HiB #4 Vaxnuevance #4	Must be <u>15 months old</u>
18 Month WCC	Hepatitis A #2 Infanrix (DTaP) #4	Hep A #2 must be at least <u>6 months after dose #1</u>
4 Year WCC	Kinrix MMRV (SQ)	Must be at least <u>4 years old</u>
11 Year WCC	TDaP #1 HPV #1 Menveo #1	HPV: Can start at 9 years of age if interested TDaP: Must be at least <u>7 years old</u>
9-15 Year WCC	HPV #2	HPV: if started before 15 years of age- 2 doses needed: Dose 2 at least 6 months after dose #1 If started after 15 years of age- 3 doses needed: Dose #2 -2 months after dose #1 Dose #3- 6 months after dose #1
16 Year WCC	Meningococcal B #1 Menveo #2	Menveo: Dose #2 is 3 to 5 years after dose #1 Meningococcal B: Bexsero brand, cannot switch between Bexsero and Trumemba
16 Year+ WCC	Meningococcal B #2 TDaP	Meningococcal B: at least <u>6 months between doses</u> TDaP: needed every 10 years (5 years for dirty wounds)

Combination Vaccines/Alternate names:

Pediarix= DTaP, HepB, Polio

Vaxneuvance= Pneumococcal

Kinrix= DTaP, Polio

MMRV= Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Varicella

TDaP= Tetanus, Diptheria, Pertussis

Menveo= Meningococcal ACYW

HPV= Human Papillomavirus
